

## **WOLSEY ROAD CLUB RULES (2018)**

1. This Club shall be called the Wolsey Road Club and shall be affiliated to any cycling organisation, which the Annual General Meeting or an Extraordinary General Meeting shall decide.

2. The management of the club shall be an Executive Committee consisting of the Club officials plus any members elected annually.

3. The Club officials shall be:- President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Honorary General Secretary, Honorary Treasurer and Racing Secretary, or as decided at the A.G.M.

4. Second Claim members shall not be allowed to win Club standard medals and certificates or Club Trophies and records, nor be eligible as Club officials, or vote at A.G.Ms, General Meetings or Extraordinary Meetings.

5. The annual subscription shall be as agreed annually at the A.G.M.

6. Annual subscriptions are due on 1st January.

7. New members elected after the 30<sup>th</sup> June shall, upon payment of the subscription, be entitled to all privileges of full membership up to 31st December in the following year.

8. The Executive Committee shall meet when necessary to transact the Club's business, four to form a quorum.

9. Every individual desirous of becoming a member shall complete an application form and submit it. After being proposed and seconded by two members the application shall be reviewed by the committee at the next meeting.

10. Members shall be liable to expulsion for unseemly conduct and the Committee shall have power to expel a member subject to confirmation at an A.G.M.

11. No member shall be allowed to take part in any club event until the relevant annual subscription has been paid.

12. The Club's financial year shall commence on 1st October and end on the 30th September, after which date the Honorary Treasurer shall prepare the Balance Sheet and Subsidiary accounts which shall be audited by an Honorary Auditor elected at the previous A.G.M.

13. The A.G.M. shall be held before the end of January and the membership informed of such date. At least seven days before such a meeting members shall be sent a copy of the agenda and audited accounts. Resolutions for the agenda of any A.G.M. shall reach the Secretary at least 21 days before the date of the meeting.

14. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called by the Executive Committee or alternatively by the Secretary upon receipt of a request signed by a third of the members subject to seven days notice. Any such meeting shall be held within 21 days of receipt of the request and the membership given seven days notice of the meeting.

15. Club trophies and medals must be claimed in writing before the end of November.

16. No alteration in, or addition to, these rules shall be made except with the consent of at least two thirds of the members present at the A.G.M. or an Extraordinary General Meeting.

### **Standard Medals & Trophies**

1. All qualifying rides for Club time trial trophies, standard medals and records shall be in open and association events that are open to all Club members. All qualifying rides shall be on any course.

Except the **Newman Trophy** - any non-dual carriageway course in East District

2. **Club Junior** trophies are open to every club member under 18 on 1st January.

**Club Juvenile** trophies are open to every club member under 16 on 1st January.

3. **Standard Medals.** Any rider wishing to enter for a Standard Medal pays an agreed entry fee per distance which lasts all season and riders need to beat the following times as agreed. All entries for standard medals must be prepaid.

**Trophies**

<b><u>B.A.R.</u></b>	Best average speed in 50, 100 miles and 12 hour time trials.
<b><u>Club Championship</u></b>	Best average speed in 25, 50 and 100 mile time trials
<b><u>25 Mile Championship</u></b>	Best average speed in four 25 mile time trials
<b><u>Haven Trophy</u></b>	Best aggregate of four times over 10 miles.
<b><u>Hill Climb</u></b>	Fastest club rider in a Club hill climb designated by the Committee
<b><u>Road Race, Cyclo X and MTB Trophies</u></b>	
Awarded by a Committee decision based on results of events for a one year period between October 1 <sup>st</sup> and September 30 <sup>th</sup> . All claimants to submit their results to the Racing Secretary before the October meeting prior to the AGM..	
<b><u>Junior B.A.R.</u></b>	Best average speed for two 10 and two 25 mile time trials
<b><u>Juvenile 10</u></b>	Best average speed in three 10 mile time trials
<b><u>Junior 10</u></b>	Fastest Junior rider in an event designated by the committee
<b><u>Ladies 10</u></b>	Fastest lady club rider in an event designated by the committee

<b><u>Ladies 25</u></b>	Fastest 25 mile time trial in season
<b><u>Novice</u></b>	Fastest 25 mile time trial during season by novice. A novice is a rider who has not previously competed at that distance
<b><u>Fixed Wheel Trophy</u></b>	Rider with fastest average speed for one 10 mile and one 25 mile time trial on fixed wheel
<b><u>Ladies B.A.R.</u></b>	Best average speed in 10, 25 and 50 mile time trials
<b><u>Vets 25 Championship</u></b>	Best aggregate on Standard over four 25 mile time trials
<b><u>Dick Newman Trophy</u></b>	Awarded to a club member achieving the fastest aggregate time in a calendar year over 10 and 25 mile time trials in open and association events. Qualifying events- any 10 and 25 on East District non-dual carriageway courses
<b><u>Short distance Improvement Trophy</u></b>	Awarded for the greatest aggregate improvement or smallest deficit on a riders best 10 and 25 mile times for the previous three seasons standing on 1st January of the current year. Performances at both distances must be recorded and both distances are considered equal.
<b><u>Pat Pepper Memorial</u></b>	Awarded to the fastest lady in the Club Open 25
<b><u>Club Ride Attendance</u></b>	Awarded for the most Saturday club ride attendance points gained during the period from October 1 <sup>st</sup> to September 30 <sup>th</sup> . Two points for full ride completion and one point for partial ride.
<b><u>Sportive Trophy</u></b>	Awarded for completion of advertised fixed distance mass participation events (sportive, Audax, reliability) completed between October 1 <sup>st</sup> and September 30 <sup>th</sup> . Main criteria is number of events. If still equal then total distance of events participated (riding to and from is excluded). If still equal then longest single event. If still equal biggest event (estimated number of participants from finish sheet). Evidence: major events - finish sheet or website finish list; local events - Strava or witness. Claimants to submit their results to the committee before the October meeting prior to the AGM.
